Administrative Amendment #1

City Council December 12, 2023:

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires entitlement grantees adopt a comprehensive, long-term plan for the use of HUD funding. The Consolidated Plan analyzes the City's housing and community development needs, with a priority focus on low- and moderate-income individuals, households, and neighborhoods, and describes long-term strategies for meeting those needs. In addition to the development of a broad policy framework, the Consolidated Plan is a five-year strategy for the investment of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) formula grant funds in the City of Modesto.

Council adopted the City of Modesto's Five-Year Consolidated Plan on August 5, 2015. The Consolidated Plan identifies plan priorities and priority populations for allocating investment of available resources among different needs. The Consolidated Plan for Program Year 2015-2020 Strategic Plan identified "H-1 Increase affordable rental housing" as a priority need with prioritized populations as the following:

- **Income level:** Extremely Low, Low
- **Family Types:** Large Families, Public Housing Residents

This Amendment revises the Strategic Plan category "H-1 Increase Affordable Housing" to additionally include the Homeless Population as a priority population for the City's HUD funding as follows:

- **Homeless:**
 - Rural
 - Chronic Homelessness
 - Individuals:
 - Families with Children
 - Mentally Ill
 - Chronic Substance Abuse
 - Veterans
 - Persons with HIV/AIDS
 - Victims of Domestic Violence
 - Unaccompanied Youth
