



# Revisions to the FT Draft Recommendations

(as of May 25)

This document summarizes the changes made to the draft recommendations between the April 27 work group meeting and the May 25 work group meeting.

1. In several places, changed “alternative response” to “alternate response” to ensure standard usage consistent with council approved themes.
2. On pages 1 and 4, updated placeholder text to reflect that we will be taking a final vote on our recommendations at our June meeting.
3. On page 3, changed “The working group... assigned members to three ad hoc groups...” to “The working group... created three ad hoc groups.... Working group members appointed themselves to one or more of the ad hoc groups based on their interests and availability.” to better reflect our actual process.
4. On page 4, added Table 1 listing all members of the Forward Together Working Group (***please make sure your name and organization are listed correctly***)
5. On page 5, added a sentence describing the purpose of the alternate response ad hoc group (begins with “The alternate response ad hoc group was formed...”)
6. On page 5 and 6, rewrote the sentence beginning with “We had a somewhat less detailed discussion...” to reflect new information provided to the ad hoc group
7. On page 6, changed “...make better use of limited policing resources, and will be highly cost effective” to “...make better use of limited policing resources, will be highly cost effective, and, most importantly, have the potential to save lives.”
8. On page 6, changed “...grow the CHAT program...” to “...grow the MCERT and CHAT programs...”
9. On page 8, reworded item 5(c) to more accurately reflect the ad hoc groups intention
10. On page 10, expanded the description of the MCERT program (see the paragraph beginning “The City was also in the process of...”)
11. On page 11, added “...and that the MCERT program be scaled up as well.” to reflect that both CHAT and MCERT need to be expanded (see the paragraph beginning “The Chief shared data...”).



12. On page 13, deleted cost estimates from item (2) in order to emphasize the need to grow CHAT and MCERT for the long-term (as opposed to reaching some fixed endpoint)
13. On page 16, added a new item 2(h) which reads: “h) Provide an annual report which identifies and explains changes made to training practices and policies and procedures, that summarizes outcomes of complaints and provides information regarding lawsuits pending and settled and sources of settlement, i. e. general fund or insurance.”
14. On page 17, edited Section III to reflect that it will be written by the facilitators, not the work group
