Neighborhood ADA Improvement Program

Project Description:

This program will provide ADA improvements to residential neighborhoods. The City maintains an ADA action list that captures citizen concerns regarding accessibility of specific locations throughout the City. Public participation will be facilitated through City’s website and social media. Concerns will be prioritized, and projects developed by City staff to improve accessibility and safety in residential neighborhoods. Anticipated improvements include compliant ramps, pedestrian refuges, signage and striping, ADA improvements, signal upgrades (detection cameras, ADA push buttons, beacons) where needed.

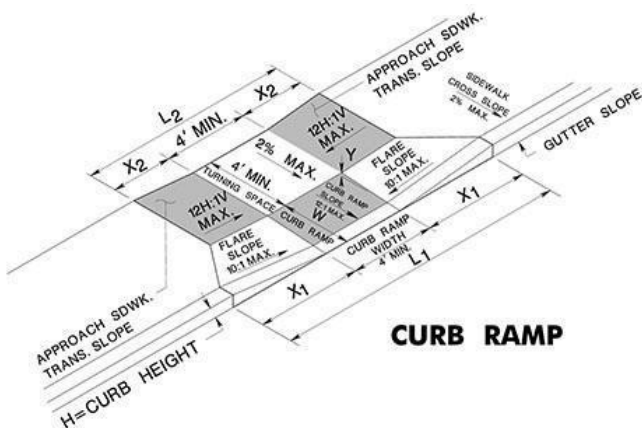

Project Status:

Materials will be prepared for the City’s website and social media presence in July 2020, with posting anticipated in August 2020. The City’s ADA Action List and website will be updated quarterly based on responses from the public, and in January 2021, a project will be selected for Measure L funding, and proposed with the next fiscal year’s projects. Staff may choose to develop a standalone project, or include the selected project with an existing project for cost effective construction.
