### 2020 Pavement Condition Survey

**Project Description:**

The City’s pavement management system requires period pavement condition surveys to evaluate the condition of pavement throughout the City. This is used to prioritize pavement rehabilitation projects. The City has been approached by StanCOG to participate in a regional pavement condition survey effort led by StanCOG, anticipated to start in 2020.
