Orangeburg Ave Pavement Rehabilitation Project Phase I (Coffee Road to Oakdale Avenue)

Project Description:

Pavement rehabilitation on Orangeburg Avenue from Coffee Road to Oakdale Avenue. The length of the project is approximately 1.0 miles, or 421,200 square feet of pavement. Anticipated project improvements include roadway resurfacing and/or reconstruction, new signage and striping, ADA upgrades, and storm drainage system improvements.
