Dry Creek Trail Pavement Rehabilitation & ADA Upgrade Project (Kewin Park to Thousand Oaks Park)

Project Description:

Pavement rehabilitation project on Dry Creek Bike Path from Kewin Park to Thousand Oaks Park. The length of the project is 0.6 miles. This is the second part of a multi-year effort to rehabilitate the Dry Creek Trail from La Loma to El Vista Avenue. Anticipated project improvements include bike path widening and resurfacing, new striping, new signage, shoulder improvements and ADA upgrades.
