How is your community impacted by the decisions made by City Council?

Everyone is impacted in various ways. To be honest, I have given up on Modesto being a beautiful tree filled farm town it once was. Modesto made a long term plan for water, however, other cities that did not plan ahead want to strong arm the water away that we all need for our food to be grown. Stop cementing over clear land, I know it's easier than bulldozing unused buildings, but it needs to be done. The city keeps spreading, eating up more and more farm land, and in turn we abandon its core. Stop trying to retro fit old buildings, it is far to costly, level it and rebuild. I see other cities, like Salt Lake City, leveled a central city high school, Granite High School, to build new homes and a few walkable stores. It was the high school my husband attended. Stop the spread of the city. I completely remodeled a home built in 1962, now it's time for the city to do the same. Make it easier to remove all of the unused buildings. And could we just rename all of the roads with 2-3 names in one fell swoop. Our street names changing everytime you cross a bridge, a train track, a canal, or just a house, needs to go. It just creates unnecessary confusion.

What else would you like to tell us about your community?

I would like to see more green space and more trees, with a 100 year plan of maintenance. Trees are being removed from the area without being replaced, the bird population is down 80% in our area from 20 years ago. I am an avid gardener and give consideration to the wildlife in how I manage my yard. And if we are expected to use less energy moving about, then we need walkable, safe, neighborhoods and shopping. I would like to feel safe walking about our town. I honestly don't right now. We no longer go down town, there is nothing of interest to me there. My husband and I have both been approached inappropriately in the last 6 months, his involved 10 officers to handle. I am truly grateful for the police officers quick response. Safety, Safety, and Green.

If we had a truly workable plan that benefits all, which I believe is possible, the community would be happy to be involved. You can't please everyone, and sometimes the answer is just "NO". "No more cemented over farm land", "No

more city sprawl". How about we recenter this city and give
back some farm land!!!
