



## NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING PROGRAM (NTCP)

### PRIORITY RANKING

Category	Element	Assigned Points
Safety	Correctable Accident Records	5 points for each Fatality 4 points for each Suspected Serious Injury 3 points for each Suspected Minor Injury 2 points for each Possible Injury 1 point for each Property Damage Only
	Vehicle Speeds	2 points for each 5 percent of vehicles that exceed 10 mph of posted limit
	Vehicle Counts	2 points for each 1,000 vehicles of Average Daily Traffic Volume
	Pedestrian Use	1 point for each 500 pedestrians per day (If data is collected)
Location	Proximity to Pedestrian Generators	3 point for proximity to transit 3 point for proximity to schools 3 point for proximity to parks 3 point for other pedestrian generators
	Proximity to Planned Projects	3 points for adjacent to planned project 2 points for within 1,000 feet of planned project 1 point for within 2,500 feet of planned project
	Distribution of Projects	Up to 5 points for distribution of projects throughout the City
Policies	Consistent with City Policy Documents	Up to 5 points for consistency with various City Planning Documents
	Neighborhood Support	1 point for each 10% neighborhood support above qualifying 60%
Financial	Benefit Cost Analysis	10 points for BCR greater than 20 5 points for BCR greater than 10 1 point for BCR greater than 1
